What does it mean to know God?

"I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me. If you really know me, you will know my Father as well." - John 14:6-7

A kindergarten teacher once told her students to draw a picture of what was important to them. In the back of the room little Johnny began to labor over his drawing. Everybody finished and handed in their picture, except for Johnny.




2023 FCF MINISTRY SPOTLIGHT Guillermo/ACIBEN Costa Rica

- •Our sister church in Ortega, Costa Rica was started by Pastor Guillermo Bonilla in 1998.
- •FCF's first contact was in 2008 when Pastor Dave met Guillermo on a discovery trip.
- •We began sending Global Impact Teams in July 2010, when we did our first VBS for the children in Ortega.
- •In the past 13 years, we have helped with youth leadership training, provided clean drinking water, constructed a two-story addition with a community cooking center, and held various evangelistic events.
- •In 2023, FCF will have 2 teams going to Costa Rica. The team going June 29-July 6 will be sharing Steller VBS, the same VBS that FCF will hold this year. The Switchback Students will be in Costa Rica July 6-13 and

Guillermo.
